

## **What's Happening Now – June 2013**

Advance Illinois is a project designed to improve the technology resources needed to support advancement functions at the University of Illinois Foundation, Alumni Association and the Campus Development and Advancement Offices. There are two primary phases of the Advance Illinois project.

The first phase of the project began last fall as teams identified requirements, developed a solution review and selection plan, posted Requests for Proposals (RFPs) to qualified software vendors, reviewed and rated RFP responses and invited vendors to demonstrate their software. A final software recommendation will be based on the functional, technical and financial fit.

The second phase, which will begin in fall 2013, consists of business process review and planning, hardware installation and configuration, conversion, testing, training and implementation.
