

What's Happening Now – August 2013

On July 15, AITS went live with the first release of the System Status application, which will replace the status pages that were supported separately by AITS and CITES. CITES followed with their respective go-live on July 17. The application consists of both a public website and a web application for use by administrators who manage events.

The website provides a joint location for information on current issues or scheduled maintenance at AITS and CITES. The website can be accessed at <http://status.uillinois.edu>. On the new site, users can opt to subscribe to real time and/or daily digest summary email notices regarding event postings and updates.

The web application allows authenticated users to post status notifications regarding planned and unplanned interruptions to services and systems. The application is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

In addition, the System Status application tracks a history of recently closed events. The project team is currently working on the full functionality release of the System Status application due out this fall.
