Dear Mr. Daniels:

I write to respond to your Freedom of Information dated December 27, 2013, and received in my office on January 2, 2014, in which you requested:

- “1. A copy of any and all documents from. the University's Police Department which describe the department's rules and restrictions placed on police officers or security personnel in regards to their socializing with individuals with a criminal history, especially if those individuals are family members or relatives.
2. The name(s) and phone number(s) of the individual(s) charged with interpreting and/or enforcing the policies referenced above.
3. Copies of any documents - such as letters, memos, e-mails, grievances, arbitration awards, etc. - which demonstrate the department's administration of its socialization policy (i.e., a letter to an officer instructing him not to have any further contact with an individual with a known criminal history).”

Information responsive to the first point of your request is available and attached. These are public documents numbering 14 pages. The contacts requested in point 2 are Police Chief Don Mitchell and Police Captain Larry Griffiths, 217-206-6690. No documents could be located responsive to point 3 of your request.

Should you wish to inspect or receive a physical copy of these documents, please call Melanie Kuehn at the phone number below and she will provide you with all necessary details.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General. The PAC may be reached by phone at 217-782-1396, by email to publicaccess@atg.state.il.us, or by postal mail at the Public Access Bureau, 500 S. 2nd Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706. You also have the right to seek judicial review under section 11 of this Act.
