I am responding to your request dated December, and then narrowed on December 17, under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act in which you request:

“• All emails sent to or from the following people in which the following underlined words are in the subject or body of the email message: “discipline”, “arrest”, “lawsuit”, “crime”, “prosecutor”, “accuser”, “police”, “cops” or “911”:

- * Mark Morris
- * Tim Beckman
- * Alex Golesh
- * Mike Thomas

Furthermore, I would like to exclude all email messages with extraneous content such as news clippings, spam and in-house newsletters.

- A spreadsheet or list of athletes who have been arrested by campus police or other law enforcement agencies. This covers athletes arrested between Jan. 1, 2008, and the present.”

A search was conducted and no records pertaining to your request could be located.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General. The PAC may be reached by phone at 217-782-1396, by email to publicaccess@atg.state.il.us, or by postal mail at the Public Access Bureau, 500 S. 2nd Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706. You also have the right to seek judicial review under section 11 of this Act.
