

Dear Mr. Dolinar:

I am responding to your request dated February 10, under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act in which you request:

"records of a public town hall meeting in Colwell Playhouse with Chancellor Phyllis Wise on December 6, 2012. I am interested in 1) any video of the event if it was recorded and 2) transcripts of the Chancellor's prepared remarks, and any question and answer period afterwards."

A search was conducted for "...records of a public town hall meeting... on December 6, 2012..." No such documents could be located. However, we did find records from a town hall meeting on December 6, 2011. The link to the town hall meeting is below. Information responsive to your request is available and attached. These are public documents numbering 13 pages.
