Dear Ms. Grayson:

I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request dated January 22, 2014 and clarified with my office on January 23, 2014, in which you requested:

**“1) The equity/revenue-and-expenses report completed by the athletic department for the National Collegiate Athletic Association for the 2013 fiscal year.** This report is a multi-page document that had to be submitted to the NCAA by Jan. 15, 2014. It contains 38 revenue and expense categories, followed by specific breakdowns of each of those categories, by sport and gender. I am requesting the full report, including the detail tables, and the Statement of Revenues and Expenses. PLEASE NOTE: The NCAA report is different than the equity report that is sent to the U.S. Department of Education for Title IX compliance.

**2) The current contracts for the men’s and women’s head basketball coaches.** If a contract is under negotiation, please forward the current contract but let me know that a new contract may be forthcoming. If there is no contact for one or both, please forward the letter(s) of intent or other document(s) outlining each coach’s conditions of employment -- including bonus structure -- and/or a current statement of salary.

**3) The current contracts for the three full-time men’s basketball assistant coaches.** If a contract is under negotiation, please forward the current contract but let me know that a new contract may be forthcoming. If there are no contracts, please forward the letters of appointment or another document that lists the coaches’ conditions of employment -- including bonus structure -- and/or their current salaries. 2

**4) The most recent athletically related outside income reports for the five coaches listed above: the men’s and women’s basketball head coaches and the three men’s basketball assistants.** This is the annual document filled out each year by all coaches to comply with NCAA bylaw 11.2.2, under which athletic personnel must report

income earned from sources other than the university. Since there is no due date specified by the NCAA please forward the most recently signed report.”

On January 23, you clarified that this request is for our Urbana and Chicago campuses.

Documents responsive to your request are available. These are public documents numbering 172 pages. Due to the size of these records, they are being made available to you for download. The URL will be provided to you separately.

Portions of these documents have been redacted pursuant to the following section(s) of the Act:

- 140/7(1)(b) that exempts from disclosure “Private information, unless disclosure is required by another provision of this Act, a State or federal law or a court order.” This includes university identification numbers and home address information.

Should you wish to inspect or receive a physical copy of these documents, please call Melanie Kuehn at the phone number below and she will provide you with all necessary details.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General. You also have the right to seek judicial review under section 11 of this Act.
