I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request of April 23, 2014, and received in my office on April 24, 2014, in which you requested:

"...all self-reported NCAA violations by all of Illinois Athletics between June and December of 2013. The request mirrors FOIA 14-141 requested by Kayla Byler of The Lantern and responded to on March 24."

Information responsive to your request is available and attached. We have included the provided records as well as our response to the requester. These are public documents numbering 149 pages.
