I am responding to your request dated and received in my office on April 8, 2014, under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act in which you request:

“I’m writing to request biweekly lighting surveys reported by UIC police for the past 52 weeks and the disposition of repairs and work orders for those repairs.”

Information responsive to your request is available and attached. These are public documents numbering 85 pages. The University included all work orders for lighting repair as it is unable to determine which work orders were created from the bi-weekly surveys. For your information, in some instances the survey reports were not conducted bi-weekly for operational reasons.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General. You also have the right to seek judicial review under section 11 of this Act.
