Dear Mr. Laugesen:

I am responding to your request dated March 20, under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act in which you request:

“I have identified 110 non-tenure-track faculty (see attached file) who were included in the response data but seem not to appear in the UI Academic and Administrative Appointments “Gray Book” for AY 2013-14.

I respectfully request the following records under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act. I am not a commercial requestor. I would prefer to receive the information free of charge, but would consider paying for it if necessary.

For each non-tenure-track faculty member listed in the attached file, I request that you provide:

employee class code/s; academic class code/s; date of current hire; information on the employee’s university-provided benefit eligibility (in particular eligibility for health insurance and SURS pension plan).”

Information responsive to your request is available and attached. These are public documents numbering 2 pages. Please note that the only data not provided here is “academic class code.” This is not a data element used/maintained, therefore the University is not able to produce the data.

As the Excel file type allows for editing of the included data, we ask that prior to opening the files you accept responsibility for accurate dissemination of this information and agree that no manipulation of the file that results in falsification of the information will occur.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General. The PAC may be reached by phone at
