Dear Dr. Scheinman:

I write to confirm receipt of your Freedom of Information request dated and received in my office on April 21, 2014, in which you requested:

- “1. All emails and all other correspondence from/to Ms. Laura Frerichs regarding Heather Minks, this correspondence to have occurred on or after 1/1/13.
2. For \*each\* redaction, a pinpoint citation to the exemption(s) under which this redaction is claimed to have been validly made.
3. For all documents entirely withheld,
  - a. For \*each\* such withheld document, a pinpoint citation to the exemption(s) under which the withholding is claimed to have been validly made;
  - b. For \*each\* such document, the length of the document, the sender(s), recipient(s), date of transmission, and the date of receipt.”

Information responsive to your request is available and attached. These are public documents numbering 13 pages.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General. You also have the right to seek judicial review under section 11 of this Act.
