"1. Regarding FOIA request 14-418. What is meant by "reports"? Eg. 1-Agg "Battery report".

Additionally, you have provided me with 301.8 Notice of Trespass Police standard operation guidelines. Is this policy or procedure? Is there a Board of Trustee policy or statute that speaks to trespass. If so, please provide.

2. To who does the university Chief of Police report to?

3. FOIA Request 14-309. You note that no safety evaluation was conducted of the African-American Cultural Center for year 2012 or 2013. Why not?"

The University does not have any document that is responsive to points 1 or 3 of your request.
