Dear Dr. Scheinman:

I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request of June 4, 2014, and received in my office on that date, in which you requested:

“All documents relating to the attached FOIA [#14-303, as included in documents responsive to #14-307], including production documents, followon FOIA narrowings etc.

In this regard:

1. Please provide a *specific* justification for each redaction in the production set you send in terms of Illinois FOIA law exemption, and who was responsible for the redaction;
2. Please provide a list of date, from, to, time and subject for each email fully withheld;”

Information responsive to your request is available and attached. This is a public document numbering 2 pages. Please note, as this request was never narrowed, no documents were ever provided to the requestor.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General. The PAC may be reached by phone at 217-782-1396, by email to publicaccess@atg.state.il.us, or by postal mail at the Public Access Bureau, 500 S. 2nd Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706. You also have the right to seek judicial review under section 11 of this Act.
