Dear Mr. Laugesen:

I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request dated August 11, 2014, and received in my office on August 12, 2014, in which you requested:

“...information concerning all full-time (i.e. employees with an FTE of .51 or greater as a faculty member) tenured and tenure-track faculty, employed at the Urbana-Champaign campus of the University of Illinois during Fall 2014, excluding all faculty members of the College of Law, Medicine at UIUC, College of Veterinary Medicine, and adjunct faculty (i.e. employees with an FTE of .50 or less and those who do not receive University benefits).

I request the following information on each of these faculty members:

first name, middle initial, last name, work email address, college, department/unit, original start date, current hire date, gender, age, campus email address (including mail code), FTE level, salary, tenure code, title, and job end date”

On August 19, 2014, we advised that the data for Fall 2014 appointments were still being processed within the system, and that we expected that more representative appointment information would be available by August 28, 2014. On August 20, 2014, you granted our office an extension of our response to that date.

Information responsive to your request is now available and attached. These are public documents and would, if printed, number 22 pages.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General.
