Dear Mr. Will:

I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request of September 26, 2014 and received in my office on that date, in which you requested:

“...possible the following information:

1. The list of all home health agencies, private-duty nursing agencies, and children’s community-based health centers which were approved by the Division of Specialized Care for Children (DSCC) to provide nursing and home health services under the Medically Fragile, Technologically Dependent (MFTD) Waiver Program in state Fiscal Year 2014.
2. The dollar amount, segregated by month and vendor, for which each of the vendors identified in item 1 were reimbursed by the DSCC to provide nursing and home health services in the MFTD Waiver Program in SFY2014.
3. The number of units of nursing and home health services, segregated by month, vendor, and type of care (RN, LPN, CNA, etc.) which each of the vendors identified in item 1 provided under the MFTD Waiver Program in SFY2014.”

Information responsive to your request is available and attached. These are public documents numbering 29 pages.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General.
