Dear Ms. Loftis:

I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request dated and received in my office on October 28, 2014, in which you requested:

"Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5, ILCS 140/1 et seq, the Policemen's Benevolent Labor Committee requests that you provide the following information:

1. In regards to the Police Officers at the University of Illinois-Chicago, the 2014 monthly Premium Rates for all Insurance Plans Offered.
2. In regards to the Police Officers at the University of Illinois-Chicago, the 2014 monthly Employer Contributions and Employee Contributions towards Premiums Rates for all Insurance Plans Offered.
3. In regards to the Police Officers at the University of Illinois-Chicago, any documents involving Canine Officers pay, care or maintenance currently in effect.
4. In regards to the Police Officers at the University of Illinois-Chicago, any documents involving Training Officers compensation currently in effect.
5. In regards to the Police Officers at the University of Illinois-Chicago, any documents involving "Detectives" or "Investigators" compensation currently in effect."

Information responsive to your request is available and attached. These are public documents numbering 62 pages. No records could be located responsive to point 3 of your request as UIC Police department does not have a canine division.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General. You also have the right to seek judicial review under section 11 of this Act.
