Dear Mr. Peek:

I am responding to your request dated November 24, 2014, and received in my office on December 1, 2014, under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act in which you request:

- “1. Any and all records from 1987 through 1989 describing federal grants to the USARMY Corps of Engineering Construction Engineering Research Lab in Champaign, Illinois, which would have paid for any employee of the University of Illinois, Urbana, Illinois, or any employee of Parkland College, Champaign, Illinois, to work at CERL during this same time period.
2. Any and all records from 1987 through 1989 describing federal grants to the University of Illinois at Urbana Champaign, Urbana, Illinois, and Parkland College, Champaign, Illinois, which would have paid for any student and/or employee of the University of Illinois or Parkland College Engineering Research Lab in Champaign, Illinois, during this same time period.
3. Any and all records, including any US Army military unit history, which shows that Mark A. Anliker worked at CERL in Champaign, Illinois during the time period of 1987 through 1989.
4. Any and all records of disbursements to the University of Illinois, Urbana, Illinois, or Parkland College, Champaign, Illinois, for the purpose of providing employees to work at CERL during the time period of 1987 through 1989.
5. Any and all Educational Partnership Agreements between the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, Urbana, Illinois and/or Parkland College, Champaign, Illinois and the US Army Corps of Engineers for the years 1987 through 1989.
6. Any other records which would tend to show that Mark A. Anliker was so employed as described above during the time period of 1987 through 1989.”

A search was conducted, and no such records could be located. Please note that our office did locate the attached document, which numbers two pages, however, the time frame is 1986-1987. Portions of this document have been redacted pursuant to the following sections of the Act:

- 140/7(1)(b) that exempts from disclosure “Private information, unless disclosure is required by another provision of this Act, a State or federal law or a court order.” This includes a social security number and/or other unique identifiers.
- 140/7(1)(c) that exempts from disclosure “Personal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which, if disclosed, would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless the disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information.” This includes a date of birth and race.

You also have the right to seek judicial review under section 11 of this Act.
