I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request dated December 1, 2014, and received in my office on that date, in which you requested:

“...the number of applicants for the waiver from Kane County, IL , requesting eligibility under the Vietnam Conflict (service between January 1, 1961, and May 7, 1965) for the academic year of 2014-2015. ”

The University received seven Children of Illinois Veterans applications from students from Kane County requesting eligibility under the Vietnam Conflict.
