Dear Ms. Lieberman:

I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request of March 20, 2014, and received in my office on that date, in which you requested:

“All full time (i.e. employees with an FTE of .51 or greater as a faculty member) tenured and tenure track faculty, who possess a terminal degree appropriate to the academic unit in which the faculty member is employed, and all full-time tenure track faculty without the appropriate terminal degree who have been employed for four consecutive semesters, excluding summer units, employed at the Springfield campus of the University of Illinois during Spring 2014.

I request the following information: first name, middle initial, last name, work email address, college, department/unit, original start date, gender, age, campus email address (including mail code), FTE level, salary, tenure code, terminal degree attained, title, and job end date.”

Information responsive to your request is available and attached. These are public documents numbering 3 pages.

Portions of these documents have been redacted pursuant to the following section(s) of the Act:

- 140/7(1)(c) that exempts from disclosure “Personal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which, if disclosed, would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless the disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information.” This includes dates of birth.

Please note you request for the employees’ age has not been provided because as that information is not tracked by the Springfield campus.

Because the XLS file type allows for editing of the included data, we ask that prior to opening the files you accept responsibility for accurate dissemination of this information and agree that no manipulation of the file that results in falsification of the information will occur.
