I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request dated February 18, and received in my office on February 19, 2015, in which you requested:

“Copies of Medical Express Ambulance Service's proposals  
Copies of the proposals for each of the four unsuccessful responsive respondents  
Copies of the contract(s) written with Medical Express Ambulance Services”

Information responsive to your request is not available. According to University records, the KDR-015 file was destroyed in January of 2014 due to the age of the documents. Therefore, we do not have the RFP proposals responsive to your request. It is our understanding that no new ambulance service RFPs have been issued since the KDR-015 proposal referenced in your request.
