I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request dated May 20, 2015 and received in my office on May 21, 2015, in which you requested:

“...corresponding information for faculty members required to submit the original Statement of Economic Interests form, which has been in effect for a number of years.”

Information responsive to your request is available and attached. This is a public document and, if printed, would number 15 pages. This list represents current employees during the 2014-2015 Academic Year who held tenure and non-tenure track positions and were requested to complete the Statement of Non-Economic Form.

The file provided to you is in XLS format. Because this file type allows for editing of the included data, we ask that prior to opening the file you accept responsibility for accurate dissemination of this information and agree that no manipulation of the file that results in falsification of the information will occur.

In your request, you also sought confirmation that we do not possess the information you sought in FOIA request 15-391. We have confirmed that the University has no documents responsive to that request.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General.
