I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request of July 7, in which you requested:

“for all emails between the University of Illinois at Urbana–Champaign sports information office and media members exchanged from March 20, 2015 to July 7, 2015 regarding any mention of the current lawsuit filed by seven former women's basketball players against the university or any of the following former student-athletes: Simon Cvijanovic, Amarah Coleman, Alexis Smith, Taylor Tuck, Nia Oden, Sarah Livingston, Taylor Gleason, or Jacqui Gran.”

Information responsive to your request is available and attached. These are public documents numbering 4 pages.

- 140/7(1)(b) that exempts from disclosure “Private information, unless disclosure is required by another provision of this Act, a State or federal law or a court order.” This includes cell phone numbers and personal email addresses.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General. You also have the right to seek judicial review under section 11 of this Act.
