Dear Mr. Gruca:

I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request dated June 16, 2015 and received in my office on June 23, 2015, in which you requested:

“...Re: Location of Public Water Supply Wells  
3000 West 36<sup>th</sup> Street  
Chicago, Illinois 60632

...any available information that may be on file at the Illinois State Water Survey concerning the above-referenced property. This information should include, but not be limited to, the presence of on-site wells, well logs, current or historical environmental concerns (e.g., groundwater impacts), permits, inspections, releases, or violations for properties within a 2,500-foot radius of the above referenced site. The site is located within the southwest quarter of Section 36, Township 39 North, Range 13 East of the Third Principal Meridian in Cook County, Illinois.”

Due to file size, the records referenced above are available for download at . This link will expire in 10 days. Because reading files in the Box interface can be slow and unwieldy, we suggest that you click the Download button to save your responsive file to your desktop. If you do choose to view the file in the Box interface, the download button appears as a white arrow at the top right of the viewing window. These are public documents and, if printed, would number 117 pages.

Portions of these documents have been redacted pursuant to the following section(s) of the Act:

- 140/7(1)(b) that exempts from disclosure “Private information, unless disclosure is required by another provision of this Act, a State or federal law or a court order.” This includes a personal addresses.
- 140/7(1)(c) that exempts from disclosure “Personal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which, if disclosed, would constitute a clearly unwarranted

invasion of personal privacy, unless the disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information.” This includes a private citizen’s name.

Per 5ILCS 140/9.5(b), you have a right, under the law, to seek a review of your status as a commercial requestor by the Public Access Counselor in the Office of the Attorney General. You also have the right to seek judicial review under section 11 of this Act.
