Dear Mr. Kish:

I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request dated July 31, 2015, and received in my office on August 3, 2015, in which you requested:

“.....request any extensions, modifications or new agreements that the university or its athletic department signed with Nike, Adidas or Under Armour since 2005. I also request any other contracts that exist between the university or its athletic department and other companies that provide athletic clothing or equipment, such as Easton, Mizuno, Speedo, Callaway, etc.”

On August 3, 2015, you confirmed that this request sought records from our Urbana campus only.

Information responsive to your request is available and attached. These are public documents numbering 36 pages. No signed agreements or contracts with Adidas or Under Armour could be located.

Portions of these documents have been redacted pursuant to the following section(s) of the Act:

- 140/7(1)(b) that exempts from disclosure “Private information, unless disclosure is required by another provision of this Act, a State or federal law or a court order.” This includes tax identification numbers.

Should you wish to inspect or receive a physical copy of these documents, please call Melanie Kuehn at the phone number below and she will provide you with all necessary details.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General. The PAC may be reached by phone at 217-782-1396, by email to publicaccess@atg.state.il.us, or by postal mail at the Public Access Bureau, 500 S. 2nd Street, Springfield, Illinois 62706. You also have the right to seek judicial review under section 11 of this Act.
