I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request dated and received in my office on August 3, 2015, in which you requested:

“...a copy of the following information be provided:

- The total amount raised by students from purchasing parking tags from the Fall 2014, Spring 2015 and Summer 2015 semesters.
- The total amount raised by faculty and staff from purchasing parking tags from the Fall 2014, Spring 2015 and Summer 2015 semesters.
- The total amount raised by parking tickets issued by UIS Police Department or any other official from the Fall 2014, Spring 2015 and Summer 2015 semesters.
- The exact usage of the funds raised from the parking operations (Ex. \$200.00 office supplies, \$1,000.00 on hanging tags, \$2,000.00 on repair materials, \$60,000 on salary, etc.)
- The ending balance revolving into the Fall of 2015.”

Information responsive to your request is available and attached. This is a public document numbering 1 page.
