I write to respond to your Freedom of Information request dated and received in my office on August 4, 2015, in which you requested:

“...electronic copies of the employment contracts for your head football coach, head basketball coach, assistant football coaches and assistant basketball coaches.”

On August 4, 2015, you clarified that your request sought records from the Urbana campus and amended your request to additionally seek employment contracts for the Head Basketball Coach and Assistant Men’s Basketball Coaches for the Chicago campus.

Information responsive to your request is available and attached. These are public documents numbering 118 pages.

Portions of these documents have been redacted or withheld pursuant to the following section(s) of the Act:

- 140/7(1)(b) that exempts from disclosure “Private information, unless disclosure is required by another provision of this Act, a State or federal law or a court order.” This includes employee identification numbers.

You have a right, under the law, to seek a review of this response by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) in the Office of the Attorney General. You also have the right to seek judicial review under section 11 of this Act.
